## Welcome to the 2017-2018 School Year and Our New Campus

Registration and Orientation are coming up soon.

Grades 6-8	Wednesday, August 16	Arrive at 9:00AM
Grades 9-10	Thursday, August 17	Arrive at 9:00AM
Grades 11-12	Friday, August 18	Arrive at 9:00AM

All student accounts must have a verifiable parent or guardian email address. The most common delay to the process happens when some of our older students don't want us to have a parent or guardian email address and claim that their parents don't have one.

**PARENTS/GUARDIANS**, if you have not yet received an email from us requesting verification, we do not have your email in the system. This will need to happen before a student starts school.

### **ALL STUDENTS**

Sign in at the office, Suite 123, and wait for a teacher to give you instructions.

You will be given a checklist sheet that must be returned to the office at the end of the day.

### **RETURNING STUDENTS, BOTH LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL**

You will need to go to two stations after signing in.

1. At Station 1, in the office, you will need to verify all contact information that we already have in Jupiter Grades. You will also get your new student ID, so be prepared for a new photo.
2. At Station 2, you will meet with Mr. Warner or Mr. Coca in Room 100 to discuss your class schedule for the year.

### **NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

1. When you sign in, please show that you have: your I-20, Proof of health insurance, Passport with visa and F-1 stamp, US Address, Guardian email and phone number.
2. You will then be directed to a classroom to begin math and English placement testing.
3. During the testing, we will ask one or two students at a time to come to the office to complete their SEVIS system check in, receive a student ID card, and be issued a school email account.
4. When your testing is completed, we will set an appointment to work with you on your class schedule.

## **NEW LOCAL STUDENTS**

**After signing in at the office**, you will go to the Multi Purpose Room. You will have a chance to meet many of the teachers and staff.

1. You will be called to the office one at a time to complete your check in process, making sure your student file is complete. Your picture will be taken, and you will receive your student ID card.
2. Next, you will meet with Mr. Warner or Mr. Coca in Room 100 to discuss your class schedule for the year.

## **ALL STUDENTS, BOTH NEW AND RETURNING**

Meet in the Multi Purpose Room at 1:00PM for an orientation.

At the end of the orientation, you will hand your signed-off checklist to a teacher, who will verify that you are ready to start the school year.

## **ABOUT ONLINE CLASS OPTIONS**

This year, we have approved a limited number of classes that can be taken online for full credit. These can be taken by students who have already proven to their current teachers that they have the self-discipline to complete assignments with very little supervision. These classes will be monitored by the sponsoring teacher. Details about how to take advantage of this option are listed on the online class request form.

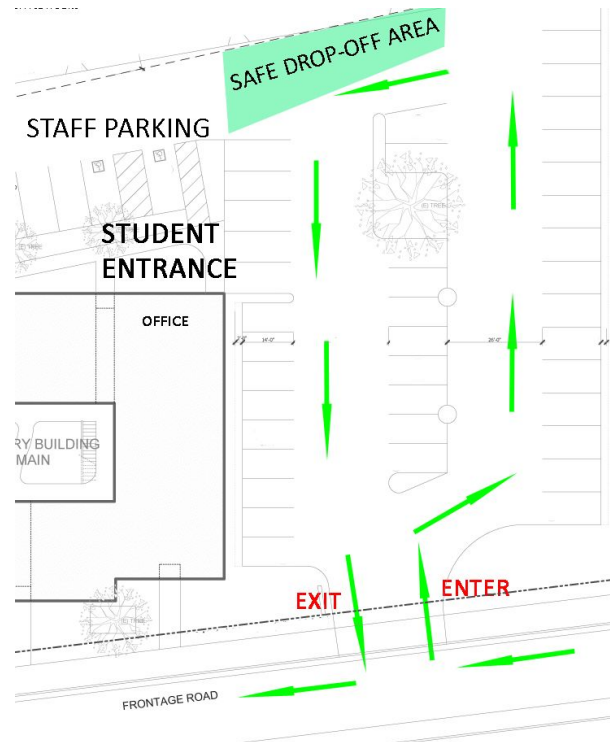
\*\*\* Concurrent enrollment for any student who has failed ANY English course to date. On-Site work required.

## STUDENT ARRIVAL DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

If you are dropping students off at school, enter from the frontage road and stay to the right. You may either park or drop off students at the rear of the parking lot near the office.

### **MONDAY, AUGUST 21** (Please note that this is a short day)

8:15AM ALL students need to be in the Multi Purpose Room (MPR) at 8:15AM  
Pick up a copy of your schedule near the MPR door.  
(By today, you will understand the schedule codes such as M1 or T2.)  
The Headmaster will offer a brief welcome.

Students will then go through an abbreviated Monday schedule (M1, M2, M3, M4, M5, M6). Each period is only 30 minutes long. This allows the teacher to hand out textbooks and syllabi, check the class rolls, and double check class placement. The students will meet their teacher and learn what to bring to the next class.

During the afternoon of this first day, faculty will be meeting with each other to discuss individual student schedules and class placement. These discussions often result in adjustments to schedules or placements, so that is why we ask students to pick up a copy of their schedule AGAIN on Tuesday morning.

### **TUESDAY, AUGUST 22**

Go to class.

### **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 23**

Due to our weekly Staff meeting, Wednesday classes start at 9:00AM. Students who have been approved for early drop-off may still arrive at 7:30AM.

9:00AM      Students will meet in the MPR at 9:00AM  
They will be introduced to the various specialty sports offered at Cambrian Academy, as well as the various clubs and activities that will be available.

Keep in mind that there are usually schedule adjustments made during the first two weeks as we get to know our new students.
