


We've finally arrived at our permanent home — 4340!


Interact is sponsored by Rotary International.






Cambrian Academy's AP Environmental Science class project was one of just four Bay Area recipients to earn this year's "Progress for Pollinators" grant from the Happy Hollow Foundation. The Cambrian Academy Restoration and Education (CARE) project is a multiphase project that seeks to restore the riparian habitat of the 250 by 40 foot stretch of

the Guadalupe River, which runs in our backyard, for the complete benefit of pollinators. We plan on using native flora that will both help conserve water and attract native pollinators. Our plan consists of three parts: river cleanup including removal of invasive species, planting of native species, and the continued education and preservation of the habitats.






A NEW CAMPUS

WASC

The Western Association of Schools and Colleges is the accrediting body that validates the class credits granted by secondary schools and colleges.

As we are approaching the end of our current six year term of accreditation, we had the huge task of preparing a self-study report of over 250 pages (much larger than your 10-page essays). WASC then sends a visiting committee to validate our report and makes the renewal recommendation to the commission. The visiting committee, made up of Dr. Ward Andrus, Dr. Angela Walker, and Ms. Yvette Aguilar, were quite impressed by the students, the staff and the Cambrian Academy program.
