
#### **ONLINE**

Four to six weeks before the start of the in-class session, a student receives access to an online program. Upon the first log-in, a short tutorial is provided, followed by the initial assessment. This assessment will validate placement and eliminate from the program any concepts that have already been mastered. A pie chart is revealed, showing concepts that the student will need to learn to complete the class. Simple tutorials are available for each topic, which help set a quick pace until the list is reduced to those concepts still requiring teacher support.

### **IN-CLASS**

Students will then work with a teacher on campus four days per week for four weeks. At the program's conclusion, a letter grade will be issued based on topics completed, along with a transcript with transferable credit.

Cambrian Academy is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, and the courses are UC approved, so they will transfer as full credit.

#### HYBRID CLASSES VALIDATED BY CAMBRIAN ACADEMY

One problem with online classes, when credit is involved, is that cheating is known to be easy. Most programs cannot validate who actually took and passed the class. Colleges have access to our school profile that explains how we validate these classes.

Classes are offered through an approved vendor we have worked with for the last 10 years that gives us access to the back end of the system. Quiz grading is automated, assignments are graded by a **live teacher**, and **Unit Tests are proctored** by a Cambrian Academy faculty member on campus. All classes are **UC approved** and accepted by the **NCAA** for athletes entering college sports.

Most students can complete a single semester during the summer.

Students may start early, but **all Unit Tests must be taken on campus** after the summer session begins. Students who need more time after July 3 may schedule afternoon Unit Tests but must complete the Final Exam by August 2.
