## SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES 2011

### Math - 4 Mornings per Week

Summer math will focus on developing the student's **abstract math skills** by reviewing the basic mathematical relationships and moving into algebraic applications. Even students who have completed an algebra class may benefit from this four-week session. These are the skills tested on the SAT, and a strong conceptual grasp is necessary to do well.

#### Pre-Algebra

The goal of Pre-Algebra is to develop fluency with rational numbers and proportional relationships. Students will extend their elementary skills and begin to learn algebra concepts that serve as a transition into formal Algebra and Geometry.

#### Algebra

The main goal of Algebra is to develop fluency in working with linear equations. Students will extend their experiences with tables, graphs, and equations and solve linear equations and inequalities and systems of linear equations and inequalities. Students will analyze situations verbally, numerically, graphically, and symbolically.

#### Geometry, Algebra 2, Precalculus<sup>3</sup>

These classes are available with the **for-credit<sup>3</sup> option**. Students who choose this option will spend all three hours (9am to noon) on the subject working with a math teacher/facilitator. You will receive credit, a grade, and a detailed printout of the specific CA standards mastered. (*minimum 6 students to run class*)

*Ideal both for advanced students and for students who need to repeat the class for a better grade.*

### English - 4 Mornings per Week

Students will hone their English grammar and composition skills using a combination of the Warriner's series and our own proprietary materials. We cover the essay styles essential to future success.

### P/SAT Prep -4 Afternoons per Week

Students will learn test-taking strategies and will build confidence using practice test materials supplied by the College Board.

High school students will open their College Board account.

### Spanish & Swimming Afternoons

The **Spanish** program, meeting two times per week, is designed for learners with little to moderate past exposure to the Spanish language. The class is mostly interactive immersion with study of vocabulary and grammar.

Students will go **swimming** two afternoons per week. Qualified lifeguards are on duty for the fun in the California sun.

Finally, on the fifth afternoon, students will enjoy either an off-campus **field trip** or an in-house **movie** and **video games**.

## Art & Swimming Afternoons

Students will enjoy a variety of **arts and crafts** activities two times per week.

Students will go **swimming** two afternoons per week. Qualified lifeguards are on duty for the fun in the California sun.

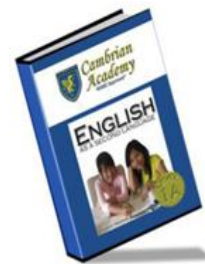
Finally, on the fifth afternoon, students will enjoy either an off-campus **field trip** or an in-house **movie** and **video games**.

## English as a Second Language - 4 Mornings per Week

Students will be immersed in ESL classes in which they learn to speak and write in the **English language**. (ESL does not qualify for discount)

Our intensive ESL program was specially designed for students from our foreign sister schools.

Our Oxford ESL workbooks relate the student's native language to the English lesson of the day, allowing students to hone their skills more quickly. Students will also practice English phonics and accent reduction.



The four-week session will end with the student preparing a video speech to send home to their families.

International students will have the opportunity to attend classes and activities with Cambrian Academy's local students and gain friendships that will later span the globe.
